Amarillo	Floral, tropical, and citrus (lemon, orange and grapefruit) aroma and flavour.	USA	8-11	Dual Purpose
Cascade	Excellent spicy flavour with floral and slightly citrus overtones to its aroma.	USA	4-7	Dual Purpose
Centennial	Well balanced medium intensity floral and citrus (lemon) tones. Sometimes called a "Super Cascade".	USA	9.5-11.5	Dual Purpose
Challenger	Cedar, green tea and sweet floral characteristics (as a late addition, it can provide crisp, fruity flavors).	UK	6.5-9	Dual Purpose
Chinook	Distinct, medium intensity spice and pine characteristics with subtle notes of grapefruit.	USA	12-14	<b>Dual Purpose</b>
Citra	Strong citrus and tropical tones of grapefruit, melon, lime, gooseberry, passion fruit and lychee.	USA	11-13	Aroma
Cluster	Strong floral and spicy characteristics. Excellent general purpose variety with balanced bittering and aroma potential.	USA	5.5-8.5	Dual Purpose
Ella	Spicy, hoppy and floral with hints of anise. Reminiscent of, yet distinctly different from, noble European varieties.	AUST	14-16	Aroma
Fuggles	Delicate and pleasant mint, grass and floral tones. The most revered and famous English hop, known for its full bodied flavor in traditional ales.	UK	3.5-6.5	Aroma
Galaxy	Distinct citrus, peach and passion fruit flavors. Typically used as a late addition - the aroma and flavor characteristics become more pronounced the later the addition.	AUST	11-16	Aroma

Goldings	Smooth and delicate with floral, lavender, spice, honey, earth, lemon and thyme overtones. A traditional English hop that has been used in kettle and dry hopping.	UK	4 - 6	Dual Purpose
Hallertau	Mild and pleasant, yet spicy, with herbal and floral characteristics. The classic German hop associated with Bavarian-style lager beers and distinguished by an intense, pleasantly harmonic bitterness.	GER	3-5	Aroma
Helga	Very mild and pleasant with delicate floral and herbal tones.	AUST	4.5-7.5	Aroma
Hersbrucker	Mild, herbal and floral characteristics, with fruity overtones. A delicate aroma hop used mainly in lager type beers.	GER	2-5	Aroma
Mosaic	Rich in Mango, lemon, citrus, earthy pine, tropical fruit, herbal and stone fruit notes.	USA	11.5-13.5	Dual Purpose
Motueka	Lively lemon and lime tones with background hints of tropical fruit.  An excellent variety for single hop bills with multiple applications.	NZ	6.5-8.5	Aroma
Nelson Sauvin	Distinct cool climate and white wine "fruitiness" with fresh crushed gooseberry and grape infused flavors.	NZ	12-13	Dual Purpose
Northern Brewer	Medium intensity, pine and mint characteristics.	USA	8-10	Dual Purpose
Pacific Gem	Fruity bouquet that closely resembles blackberries. A bittering hop that is also used in all capacities for its rich properties.	NZ	13.5-15	Bittering
Perle	Delicate floral, fruit, spice and mint tones. A highly acceptable aroma variety with balanced bittering characteristics.	GER	6-10	Aroma
Pride of Ringwood	A pronounced and pleasant aroma with cedar, oak and herbal tones. Predominantly used for early kettle additions.	AUST	8.5-10.5	Bittering
Saaz	Very mild, with pleasant earthy, herbal and floral overtones.	CZECH	2-5	Aroma

Simcoe	Unique passion fruit, pine, earth and citrus characteristics. Known as a bittering hop with a good aroma.	USA	12-14	Dual Purpose
Sticklebract	An excellent bittering hop that also displays a piney citrus character.	NZ	13-14	Dual Purpose
Summer	Balanced citrus, melon and light apricot tones. Dry hopping displays distinct stone fruit and melon characteristics.	AUST	5.5-6.5	Dual Purpose
Super Alpha/Dr Rudi	Fresh citrus peel, pine and lemongrass flavors.	NZ	10-12	Dual Purpose
Target	An intense English hop aroma with distinct spicy, floral, sage and citrus characteristics. An excellent bittering hop that tends to be too harsh for aroma purposes late in the boil.	UK	8.5-13.5	Bittering
Tettnanger	Mild and pleasant with balanced earthy, herbal and floral aroma impressions.	GER	3-6	Aroma
Topaz	Resinous, grassy tones with light tropical flavors. Dry hopping produces resinous characteristics while tropical tones are found in higher gravity beers.	AUST	13.5-18	Dual Purpose
Vic Secret	Clean, distinct fruit and pine characters best accessed by dry hopping or whirlpool additions.	AUST	14-17	Aroma
Waimea	Intense tangelo and citrus fruit with subtle pine characteristics. Can be used across a wide variety of beer styles and applications.	NZ	16-19	Dual Purpose
Willamette	Fragrant spicy woody aroma. An excellent aromatic hop for American ales and lagers.	USA	4-6	Aroma
